The Latest

The B-Mets and Harrisburg were rained out yesterday, prompting today's doubleheader... Michel Abreu drove in three while Wilson Batista scored three times, helping the Binghamton Mets to a 6-1 win over the Harrisburg Senators in Saturday's series opener at Commerce Bank Park... Abreu was 2 for 5, getting Binghamton on the board with a run-scoring single in the first before driving in two with a fourth-inning double... Batista, playing for the first time in a week, went 3 for 5, extending his hit streak to 13 games... Tim McNab, getting his second straight spot start, tossed 5 1/3 scoreless innings, striking out five... the win is Binghamton's 10th in their last 16 games, improving them to 3-2 on their seven-game road trip, which started in Akron.

About Binghamton

Saturday's win means Binghamton's won seven of their last 10 road contests, a streak that started 6/7. Prior to that, Binghamton was 7-19 away from home... with McNab lasting into the sixth Saturday, B-Mets starters have gone at least five innings in 10 of the last 11 games, the only exception being William Collazo, who lasted 4 2/3 IP Fri. @ AKR... through the first five games of the road trip, Binghamton's hitting .300 (54 for 180) with 24 runs scored... Saturday, reliever Eddie Camacho was charged with an earned run, as the B-Mets' bullpen's allowed 6 ER in their last three games after yielding just 3 ER over a seven-game stretch.

About Harrisburg

The Senators are coming off a four-game series split with Altoona at Commerce Bank Park... they've won 13 of their last 19 games, a stretch that began when they took two of three at Binghamton 6/2-4... while Harrisburg is third in the league in hitting (.260), their 4.13 ERA is the EL's worst... the Senators are managed by John Stearns, who skippered the B-Mets in 2003. Stearns made several trips to NYSEG Stadium last season, when he served as the NY Mets' Catching Coordinator.

This 'N That

The B-Mets have lost both the twinbills they've played this season and have lost or split 10 of the 11 doubleheaders they've played over the last two seasons, with their only doubleheader sweep during that stretch occurring 8/5/2005 vs. POR... Saturday, Kevin Rios got his fourth straight start, going 9 for 16 over the four games. Prior to the Akron series, Kevin hadn't played in 10 days... Saturday, Wilson Batista extended his hit streak to 13 games, a B-Mets season high. Batista, who has a hit in every game he's played in June, is hitting .351 (20 for 57) during the streak.

Gave up a run in the second on Ivan Ochoa's two-out single, but settled down to retire 15 of the last 18 to face him, walking Brad Snyder twice and giving up a single to Ryan Mulhern during that stretch...allowed six balls in the air to the outfield, four of which were outs...won third straight start.

This Season

Making 15th professional start, 11th with Binghamton ...has been brilliant in five starts since lasting a season-low 2/3 IP 5/20 vs. ALT (3-0, 1.38, 32 IP, 9 BB, 36 K), leaving with a chance to win and throwing 6+ innings in all five...left on the losing end in four straight starts 5/4-20, posting a 5.40 ERA over that stretch, allowing 36 hits and 10 walks in 16 2/3 innings...allowed three earned runs or fewer in nine of his 10 B-Mets outings...opponents hit .395 with RISP in first seven B-Mets starts, but are 1 for 11 in such scenarios in his last three outings ...has allowed one homer with Binghamton (Bronson Sardinha, TRE) and none in last 31 2/3 innings (4+ starts)...after walking two in four starts with St. Lucie, has issued two or more free passes in six of his 10 outings with Binghamton...called up to Binghamton 4/28...2-1, 1.64 in 4 GS with St. Lucie, walking two and striking out 26 in 22 innings...a member of the Mets' 40-man roster.

Earned a no-decision 6/2 vs. HAR (6 IP, 2 R, 4 H, 2 BB, 10 K), tying his season high for strikeouts...gave up a leadoff single to Melvin Dorta in the first, but then set down the next 10 in a row...allowed both runs in the fourth, when he walked two before giving up back-to-back two-out RBI singles to Salomon Manriquez and Dan Dement...retired seven of the final eight to face him.

Background

From Wichita, KS...signed a four-year Major League contract with the Mets in January, 2006 that included a club-record \$3.55 million signing bonus...Mets' first round pick in the 2005 draft and ninth selection overall...33-7 with a school-record 2.18 ERA in three seasons at Wichita State (KS) University, striking out 366 and walking only 69 in 359 2/3 innings...Missouri Valley Conference Pitcher of the Year for an unprecedented second straight year in 2005, going 12-3 with a 1.93 ERA in 19 starts, striking out 143 and walking 30 in 139 2/3 innings ...drafted in the 15th round by Tampa Bay in 2002 out of Wichita Heights (KS) High School, but did not sign...Kansas' Gatorade Player of the Year in 2001.

Making 15th start ...lasted 5+ innings in 13 of his 14 starts...yielded three earned runs or less in 11 of his 14 outings...hasn't walked more than two in 13 of his starts, issuing 17 free passes all season...opposing hitters are batting .342 against him with 3 HR and 8 2B with runners in scoring position ...17 of the 38 ER he's allowed have come in the fifth and sixth innings (7.78 ERA). Has a 3.20 ERA otherwise...hasn't allowed a HR in three of his last four starts...0-0 in first three starts despite giving up just six runs in 16 innings of work (3.38 ERA), yielding three runs or fewer in all three...has started four games that have gone into extra innings.

Native of St. Teresa, Venezuela...didn't pitch until June 27th last season when he made one appearance for the Rookie GCL Mets...joined High-A St. Lucie in July and went 3-2, 4.13 in 12 G, 11 GS...allowed 3 ER or fewer in his 11 starts with St. Lucie ...Underwent reconstructive elbow (a.k.a. "Tommy John") surgery 5/2004...2-2, 2.75 in 4 G, 3 GS for St. Lucie in '04...SAL All-Star in 2003, going 13-6, 3.47 for Low-A Capital City...2-7 despite a 3.59 ERA for SS-A Brooklyn in 2002. Threw first CG SHO in Cyclones history 8/23 vs. Lowell (H, 0 BB, 6 K), coming within one out of a no-hitter...3-8, 4.42 in 14 G, 13 GS with Rookie Kingsport in 2001...4-3, 3.22 in 18 G, 12 GS in the Rookie Venezuelan Summer League in 2000...entering 2006, has just 76 BB in 429 career IP, averaging 1.6 BB/9 IP...signed by the Mets in 7/1999 as an international free agent.
