### The Latest

Three players had three-hit games as part of a 13-hit attack that helped the Binghamton Mets to a 6-4 win over the Harrisburg Senators at NYSEG Stadium yesterday...Jorge Padilla went 3 for 4 with an RBI double and three runs scored, Michel Abreu had a double and drove in two as part of his 3-for-4 night and Carlos Gomez had a triple and two bunt singles for his 3-for-4 performance...starting pitcher Rich Rundles beat his former team to earn his first win as a B-Met, allowing an earned run over 6 1/3 innings...the win is Binghamton's season-high-tying eighth straight and 20<sup>th</sup> in their last 25 games.

### About Binghamton

The B-Mets' offense has been on fire during the eight-game win streak, scoring 54 runs while hitting .355 (94 for 265)...the B-Mets continued their recent dominance at home, winning for the 12<sup>th</sup> time in their last 14 games at NYSEG Stadium...yesterday, Trenton beat Akron and Portland was idle, putting Binghamton 2 1/2 games behind the second-place Thunder and 3 behind first-place Portland...the eight-game win streak is tied for the second-longest in B-Mets history. The B-Mets also won eight in a row 6/30-7/8 & 8/17-23/2002. The club record of 15 straight wins was accomplished 7/22-8/8/2000.

### About Harrisburg

The Senators are coming off a three-game sweep at the hands of Altoona, giving Harrisburg losses in five straight and seven of their last eight...Harrisburg's 90 homers lead the EL...the Senators are managed by John Stearns, who skippered Binghamton in 2003. Harrisburg also has outfielder Prentice Redman, who played for the B-Mets in 2002 & 2004-2005.

### This 'N That

After falling Wednesday, New Hampshire lost all 10 games it played at NYSEG Stadium this season, as the B-Mets swept a home season series of longer than four games for the first time in team history...since starting 23-35, Binghamton's won 31 of their last 45, a streak that started with an eight-run eighth that led to a come-from-behind victory 6/7 @ REA, winning or splitting 11 of their 14 series during this stretch... Carlos Gomez has hit safely in 19 of his last 20 games, batting .440 (33 for 75) over that span to raise his batting average 53 points...four of the last five B-Mets starters have gone 6+ innings after a nine-game stretch in which the starters lasted six or more innings just twice...Binghamton's 19-5 mark in July is the EL's best while their 2.99 ERA in the month is second to Altoona.

Tossed fifth no-hitter in B-Mets history...retired first 19 in a row, allowing only four balls out of the infield...with one out in the seventh, SS Corey Ragsdale committed a throwing error that allowed Matt Van Der Bosch to reach, ending the perfect game. However, Miguel struck out Chad Spann and got Luis Jimenez to ground out to complete the no-hitter.

#### This Season

Making 21<sup>st</sup> start...12 SHO IP over last two starts, retiring 35 of the 38 hitters he's faced, earning him EL Pitcher of the Week honors for the week ending 7/23...3-0, 1.17 in last four starts, allowing just 8 H in 23 IP...lasted 5+ innings in 19 of his 20 starts and has departed in the sixth inning four times without recording an out in that frame...yielded 3 ER or less in 16 of his 20 starts...hasn't walked more than two in 17 of his starts...allowed 7+ H 11 times, but hasn't done so in last four starts...25 of the 48 ER he's allowed have come in the fifth and sixth innings (7.85 ERA). Has a 2.46 ERA otherwise...has started a game in five of the six doubleheaders the B-Mets have played this year.

0-1, 4.50 in 2 GS vs. the Senators...last loss came 6/26 @ HAR, G2 (5 IP, 3 R, 7 H, BB, K), with Kory Casto driving in two of Harrisburg's three runs in a game that was called after five innings with Harrisburg winning 3-0...no-decision 6/3 vs. HAR (5+ IP, 2 R, 5 H, 2 BB, K), departing after allowing three straight hits and both of his runs in the sixth. Left with a 3-2 lead in a game Binghamton lost 6-4 in 12 innings...Casto is 5 for 6 with a HR, 2B and 3 RBI against Miguel this season.

Native of St. Teresa, Venezuela...didn't pitch until 6/27 last season when he made one appearance for the Rookie GCL Mets...joined High-A St. Lucie in July and went 3-2, 4.13 in 12 G, 11 GS...allowed 3 ER or fewer in his 11 starts with St. Lucie ...Underwent reconstructive elbow (a.k.a. "Tommy John") surgery 5/2004...2-2, 2.75 in 4 G, 3 GS for St. Lucie in '04...SAL All-Star in 2003, going 13-6, 3.47 for Low-A Capital City...2-7 despite a 3.59 ERA for SS-A Brooklyn in 2002. Threw first CG SHO in Cyclones history 8/23 vs. Lowell (H, 0 BB, 6 K), coming within one out of a no-hitter...3-8, 4.42 in 14 G, 13 GS with Rookie Kingsport in 2001...4-3, 3.22 in 18 G, 12 GS in the Rookie Venezuelan Summer League in 2000...entering 2006, has just 76 BB in 429 career IP, averaging 1.6 BB/9 IP...signed by the Mets in 7/1999 as an international free agent.
