### The Latest

The Akron Aeros put together four different multi-run innings, defeating the Binghamton Mets 5-3 and 8-1, sweeping Monday's doubleheader at NYSEG Stadium...Fernando Martinez had multi-hit games in each contest for the B-Mets, going 4 for 8 with an RBI and a run scored...Miguel Negrón drove in two of Binghamton's runs in the first contest, picking up a double and sac fly in two at-bats. Mike Nickeas also had a double in Game 1 amongst his two hits, scoring a run...starter Marcos Carvajal got the loss in Game 1 and Game 2 starter Mike Swindell, who was making his B-Mets debut, got hung with a defeat as well...the B-Mets have lost three in a row.

#### About Binghamton

The B-Mets and Akron will play another doubleheader today, the first time Binghamton's played twinbills on back-to-back days since 8/15-16, 2005 POR...after allowing 2 R over 14 innings, the Binghamton bullpen has allowed 7 ER in 10 1/3 innings over the last three games (6.10 ERA)...the back-to-back wins over POR on Friday and Saturday are the first for the B-Mets since 8/29-30, 2006, when they took two straight from POR at NYSEG Stadium...Since moving to the top spot in the order 13 starts ago, Martinez is batting .393 (22 for 56), hitting safely in 12 of the 13 contests. Martinez has had multi-hit games in six of his last seven starts.

#### About Akron

The Cleveland Indians affiliate arrives in Binghamton after dropping two of three @ AL...the Aeros lead the EL with a .270 average and 150 runs scored and they're tied for first with 33 steals...Akron recently added former B-Mets LHP Rich Rundles from extended spring training...snow and cold weather wiped out Binghamton's season-opening series at Akron 4/5-7, Binghamton's only visit to Canal Park this season.

#### This 'N That

The B-Mets are 5-6 in the last 11 games in which they've had a lead...the B-Mets have been outscored 46-16 in the first two innings this season...Binghamton's had nine postponements and, after today, still needs to make up five games as part of doubleheaders. All five of those doubleheaders will be played at NYSEG Stadium...Binghamton's postponed series vs. NB 4/16-18 is only the second series postponed in NYSEG/Municipal Stadium history and the sixth postponed series in team history (also 4/5-7/2007 @ AKR, 5/23-26/2006 @ POR, 4/7-9/2003 @ New Haven, 4/6-8/2001 @ POR and 4/21-23/2000 vs. POR). 2007 is also the first season in club history in which more than one series has been postponed.

With two outs and no one on, Michael walked the bases loaded before former B-Met Gil Velazquez cleared them with a three-run triple...allowed just 2 H and 2 BB after the 1<sup>st</sup>, retiring 10 of the last 12 he faced...3<sup>rd</sup> CG as a B-Met and 7<sup>th</sup> of career.

Also led the Mets system in walks (70) and batting average against (.196)...tied for the Minor League Baseball lead with 4 CG and 3 SHO...4-2, 3.06 in 11 G, 10 GS with B-Mets, tossing two complete-game shutouts, tying him for first in the EL...CG SHO in AA debut 7/6 @ BOW, G2 (2 H, BB)...called up to Binghamton 7/6...Florida State League All-Star with High-A St. Lucie, going 8-3, 1.62 in 16 starts, throwing two complete games, including a shutout...second in the FSL in ERA and tied for third in wins upon his call-up...didn't allow a run in five of his last seven starts 5/31-7/1, going 4-0 with a 0.59 ERA during that stretch, tossing a pair of complete games...32-inning scoreless streak 6/5-7/1 that stretched over six starts...6+ IP in six of last seven outings with St. Lucie...10-4, 3.88 with Low-A Hagerstown in 2005, leading South Atlantic League with a .214 average against...spent 2004 with SS-A Brooklyn, finishing second in the NY-Penn League with a 1.95 ERA to go along with a 5-0 record in 14 starts...selected by the Mets in the 23<sup>rd</sup> round of the 2004 draft out of Concordia (OR) University...second-team NAIA All-American as a senior at Concordia in 2004, going 7-2, 2.37...OF/DH on days he didn't pitch, finishing second in the conference with a .409 average in '04, hitting 10 HR and driving in 42 runs over 41 games.
