### The Latest

The Connecticut Defenders got all their runs in the fifth, defeating the Binghamton Mets 3-1 at Dodd Stadium Tuesday...B-Mets starter Kevin Mulvey retired the first 11 in a row before working out of a bases-loaded jam in the fourth. Binghamton committed two errors that led to three unearned runs in the fifth...the B-Mets picked up an unearned run in the sixth when Corey Ragsdale walked and later scored on an error...Connecticut starter Geno Espineli held the B-Mets to an unearned run over seven innings, striking out seven...the B-Mets have dropped their first two games in Connecticut.

#### About Binghamton

Since moving to the second spot in the order, Mark Kiger has reached in the first inning in six straight games, scoring three times. Each time, he's reached with one out...B-Mets pitchers have allowed four or more runs in eight of the last 11 games...Mike Carp started the first 20 games of the year at first base, but since he went down with a broken finger on 5/3, five different players have played first – Brett Harper, Kiger, J.E. Cruz, Jose Reyes and Miguel Negrón. Out of that group, only Harper had played more than five games at first prior to this season...the B-Mets are in the middle of an 11-games-in-11-days road trip to POR, CON and NH, just the second 11-day trip in team history (8/9-19, 1993 – London, NB, Albany).

#### About Connecticut

The San Francisco Giants affiliate enters this series after dropping three in a row vs. REA...the Defenders are last in the EL in runs scored (125) and batting average (.238), but their pitching staff has the league's third-best ERA (3.49)...Connecticut manager Dave Machemer is in his third season with the Defenders and fifth consecutive year as a skipper in the EL.

#### This 'N That

Dating back to 2005, Binghamton's lost 13 of their last 19 games at Connecticut's Dodd Stadium...only once in the last seven games has a B-Mets starting pitcher lasted six innings...Binghamton's had nine postponements and still needs to make up five games as part of doubleheaders. All five of those doubleheaders will be played at NYSEG Stadium...Binghamton's postponed series vs. NB 4/16-18 is only the second series postponed in NYSEG/Municipal Stadium history and the sixth postponed series in team history (also 4/5-7/2007 @ AKR, 5/23-26/2006 @ POR, 4/7-9/2003 @ New Haven, 4/6-8/2001 @ POR and 4/21-23/2000 vs. POR). 2007 is also the first season in club history in which more than one series has been postponed.
