### The Latest

Travis Ishikawa led off the bottom of the ninth with a homer, giving the Connecticut Defenders a 2-1 win over the Binghamton Mets at Dodd Stadium Sunday...the B-Mets got on the board in the fourth, thanks to Mark Kiger's RBI double that scored Brett Harper. Kiger and Harper each finished with two hits, as did Fernando Martinez...starter Kevin Mulvey allowed a run on six hits and no walks over a season-high-tying seven innings...Ishikawa homered off Tim McNab, who'd pitched a scoreless eighth...the B-Mets lost two of three at Connecticut, dropping six of their last eight overall.

#### About Binghamton

Entering the six-game road trip to TRE & CON, the B-Mets were 0-17 when trailing after eight innings. However, both of Binghamton's wins on the trip came when trailing after eight (Saturday @ CON, 6/6 @ TRE). In addition, two of their four losses on the trip were walk-offs (Sunday @ CON, Thursday @ TRE)...the B-Mets led for a total of one half-inning in their just-concluded series @ CON – in the bottom of the ninth inning Saturday...since a seven-game stretch that saw him bat .531, pick up six multi-hit games and raise his average to an even .400, Corey Coles is 0 for his last 8...Thursday's 5-4, 14-inning loss at Trenton took 5:13 to play, making it the first five-hour game in team history while surpassing the previous record of 4:49 that was achieved twice in 2006. Binghamton also stole a club-record eight bases, breaking the previous mark of seven accomplished 5/9/1997 vs. TRE. B-Mets hitters walked 13 times, surpassing the previous mark of 12 set 8/7/1993 vs. Albany.

#### About Reading

The Philadelphia Phillies affiliate was swept by Trenton over the weekend. Reading's lost four in a row and eight of 11...the Phillies are third in the EL in hitting (.274), second in runs scored (295) and tied for first in homers (50)...Kyle Kendrick, today's scheduled starter for Reading, has been called up to Philadelphia to replace the injured Freddy Garcia. Kendrick will make his Major League debut with a start Wednesday.

#### This 'N That

SS Jose Coronado is the only B-Met who's played every inning of every game...Binghamton's had nine postponements and still needs to make up five games as part of doubleheaders. All five of those doubleheaders will be played at NYSEG Stadium...Binghamton's postponed series vs. NB 4/16-18 is only the second series postponed in NYSEG/Municipal Stadium history and the sixth postponed series in team history (also 4/5-7/2007 @ AKR, 5/23-26/2006 @ POR, 4/7-9/2003 @ New Haven, 4/6-8/2001 @ POR and 4/21-23/2000 vs. POR). 2007 is also the first season in club history in which more than one series has been postponed.
