### The Latest

The Binghamton Mets limited the New Hampshire Fisher Cats to two hits en route to a 4-3 win at NYSEG Stadium Wednesday... Marcos Carvajal earned the win with six innings of one-hit ball, striking out eight. He was followed by Kevin Tomasiewicz, Brandon Nall and Carlos Muñiz, with Muñiz getting the final four outs for the save... Jamar Hill had an RBI double and J.E. Cruz drove in a run with a single as part of a three-run second. Mark Kiger hit a solo homer in the sixth... the win is Binghamton's third in their last five games.

#### About Binghamton

Wednesday's two-hitter vs. NH is Binghamton's first nine-inning two-hitter since Bryan Edwards, Ivan Maldonado and Luz Portobanco combined for one 5/31/05 vs. AKR. Since then, B-Mets pitchers have tossed five seven-inning games in which they've allowed two or fewer hits, including one no-hitter... Binghamton's scored three runs or fewer in 15 of their last 26 contests... B-Mets starters have posted a 3.49 ERA (46 ER, 118 2/3 IP) in the last 21 games, tossing six or more innings 13 times, but they have only five wins over that stretch. Four other starters have left games with a chance to win, including Jose Sanchez twice.

#### About New Hampshire

The Toronto Blue Jays affiliate has won six in a row after sweeping a four-game set @ POR... the Fisher Cats have taken 10 of their last 13 on the road... New Hampshire's third in the EL in homers (73), with Sergio Santos (14 - 3<sup>rd</sup>) and Chip Cannon (13 - t-4<sup>th</sup>) both in the top five.

#### This 'N That

RHP Kevin Mulvey and manager Mako Oliveras will both participate in Sunday's Futures Game in San Francisco. Mulvey was named to replace RHP Matt Garza on the US team while Oliveras will serve as a coach for the World team. Oliveras will miss Binghamton's three-game series vs. CON Sat-Mon... SS Jose Coronado is the only B-Met who's played every inning of every game... the fathers of Drew Butera (Sal), J.E. Cruz (Jose) and Brett Harper (Brian) all played in the Majors, as did the father of hitting coach Nelson Silverio (Tom)... Binghamton had nine games postponed in April and they still need to make up four games as part of doubleheaders. All four of those doubleheaders will be played at NYSEG Stadium... Binghamton's postponed series vs. NB 4/16-18 is only the second series postponed in NYSEG/Municipal Stadium history and the sixth postponed series in team history (also 4/5-7/2007 @ AKR, 5/23-26/2006 @ POR, 4/7-9/2003 @ New Haven, 4/6-8/2001 @ POR and 4/21-23/2000 vs. POR). 2007 is also the first season in club history in which more than one series has been postponed.

Also led the Mets system in walks (70) and batting average against (.196)...tied for the Minor League Baseball lead with 4 CG and 3 SHO...4-2, 3.06 in 11 G, 10 GS with B-Mets, tossing two complete-game shutouts, tying him for first in the EL...CG SHO in AA debut 7/6 @ BOW, G2 (2 H, BB)...called up to Binghamton 7/6...Florida State League All-Star with High-A St. Lucie, going 8-3, 1.62 in 16 starts, throwing two complete games, including a shutout...second in the FSL in ERA and tied for third in wins upon his call-up...32-inning scoreless streak 6/5-7/1 that stretched over six starts...6+ IP in six of last seven outings with St. Lucie...10-4, 3.88 with Low-A Hagerstown in 2005, leading South Atlantic League with a .214 average against...spent 2004 with SS-A Brooklyn, finishing second in the NY-Penn League with a 1.95 ERA to go along with a 5-0 record in 14 starts...selected by the Mets in the 23<sup>rd</sup> round of the 2004 draft out of Concordia (OR) University...second-team NAIA All-American as a senior at Concordia in 2004, going 7-2, 2.37...OF/DH on days he didn't pitch, finishing second in the conference with a .409 average in '04, hitting 10 HR and driving in 42 runs over 41 games.
