



Binghamton Mets Media Relations Internship

Robert Ford, the Director of Broadcasting and Media Relations for the Binghamton Mets, Double-A affiliate of the New York Mets, is hiring an intern for the 2009 season. Duties will include:

- Writing and updating game notes for all games, home and away.
- Writing game recaps for home games that will be used on the B-Mets' website and e-mailed to media.
- Putting together stat packs for media and coaches
- Maintaining the press box during all home games.
- Serving as a liaison between B-Mets players and coaches and media.
- Assisting other members of the front office staff with daily operations as needed.

Previous media relations experience is a plus. The intern will receive a small stipend and can do the internship for college credit. This internship will require the chosen candidate to work long hours for little pay, but it will serve as excellent preparation for those who are interested in a career in media relations. The Binghamton Mets' season starts April 8th and their home opener is April 16th, but the chosen candidate can start once his or her school year is over.
